We are pleased to announce that the 2026 Mathematics Classroom Teaching Research for All Students (M-CTRAS) Conference will be held in a hybrid format. To accommodate participants across different time zones, the online sessions and the in-person sessions in China will take place simultaneously. This conference will be held in Beijing Normal University Zhuhai Campus from June 26-29, 2026, beginning each day at 8:00 AM (Beijing Time).

The local organizer for the conference is Beijing Normal University. This hybrid conference is also conducted in partnership with the University of the Philippines Open University.

Background of M-CTRAS

The M-CTRAS organization is an inclusive and collaborative community dedicated to advancing research and practice in mathematics education. The organization comprises mathematics educators, college students, and K-12 classroom teachers. Since its inception, the M-CTRAS has expanded to numerous universities and school districts across various countries and regions, spanning from East to West. Together, we will bridge the gap between pedagogical theory and data-informed practice to foster meaningful and equitable student learning.

Submissions and Important Deadlines

Contributions on the theme, including practical applications, theoretical frameworks, methodologies, technologies, and socio-cultural or linguistic perspectives, are welcome. Submissions may include project reports, ongoing research studies, or conceptual proposals. The official conference language is English. All contributions submitted must be in English and in abstract format (between 250-300 words).

Travel and Transportation

For overseas visitors in the campus, the Beijing Normal University, Zhuhai is accessible through various airports. (Source: https://www.bnuz.edu.cn/en_bnuz/BNUZ_Life/Transportation/Pathway_to_BNUZ.htm)

1. *Shenzhen International Airport, Macau International Airport, and Guangzhou Baiyun Airport*

From here, take the Airport Bus to Zhuhai-stop at Xiangzhou, then take the No. 10A Bus to BNUZ.

2. *Hong Kong International Airport*

From here, take the Airport Ferry (Skypier) to Zhuhai Jiuzhou Port, take a taxi to BNUZ.

You may also take a 7-seater business shuttle vehicle directly from Hong Kong Airport to Zhuhai Port.

3. For those arriving from other parts of China, and arriving by Light Rail or bus, you may arrive at:

Zhuhai North Station, Gongbei Bus Station, Xiangzhou Bus Station, and Tangjia Bus Station

From here, you may take the Zhuhai North Bus Line a or 10A bus, then get off at BNUZ.
